President Carolyn Purnell called the meeting to order at 10:18 a.m. She thanked the Board for a busy but wonderful 2011 for the Art Center.

**Minutes:** Read by Dorothy C. Jane moved and Georgia seconded they be accepted. Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Submitted by Sallee. We are still getting donations for "This Old Bag." We have had advertising costs and the Property Tax is due December 20. The 2011 classes broke about even, we need to promote them better somehow. We have about \$3k in savings, so things are looking ok. Dorothy B. moved we accept the report for audit. Barbara Santos seconded it and the vote passed.
