## MINUTES OF POCATELLO ART CENTER BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING HELD OCTOBER 6<sup>TH</sup> 2011

President Carolyn Purnell called the meeting to order at 10:25 a.m.

Present were: Carolyn Purnell, Joan Wilson, Sallee Gasser, Peggy Anderson, Barbara Santos, Bertie North, Barbara North, Becky Petersen, Jane Guidinger, Anne Merkley, Georgia Orwick, Marlene Keller, Bob Rush, Dorothy Brzek. Dorothy Brzek substituted for Secretary Dorothy Chatterton who was excused from the meeting.

President Purnell asked for corrections to the Minutes of the September meeting. The date of the Mayor's Awards for the Arts, was corrected from October 1, to October 13<sup>th</sup>. Bob Rush moved that the minutes be accepted as corrected. Georgia Orwick seconded the Motion.

Treasurer's Report: Sallee Gasser reported rental money, came in from Rem West, the income will be about \$900.00 a month. She has one outstanding bill from ISU from Sagebrush Arts Fest. Total expenses were \$2,898.56. Total checking and savings account balance is \$3,949.68. Bob Rush moved to accept the treasurer's report subject to audit. Motion seconded by Jane Guidinger.

### Committee Reports:

**Facility: Jan Stanek** - Jan was excused. President Purnell reported there was a plumbing problem and that Tal Sampson had been called.

**Desk Volunteers- Carolyn Purnell:** Maggie Millward is back on the desk on Wednesday afternoons. More desk volunteers and substitutes are needed.. Sarah Faye Carney has resigned, so we need a new librarian. A desk volunteer also needed for Thursday afternoons, 1:00- 4:00 p.m. as Leona Smith is scheduled for hip replacement surgery on November 3.

President Purnell noted the Board previously tabled discussion on developing a program for volunteer hours being transferred to a credit system for taking classes, etc. This matter will called up for discussion in November. She asked the Board weigh the pros and cons of such a system. Be visionary. Such a program would require a chairman with strict guidelines developed.

**Capital Exhibit:** Bob Rush and Roger Boe returned the Capitol Exhibit from Boise. Bob reported the curator had everything ready for them when they arrived in Boise.

**Membership: Barbara Santos.** We have 240 members. 158 paid up to date and 41 new members as of January 2011- 31 from Sagebrush Arts Fest. 7 new and the rest returning.

**Portneuf Valley Photo Society: Becky Petersen:** Roger Boe will present a program on Travel Photography, at their regular meeting on October 27, at 7:30 p.m. Larry Petersen will teach a Photoshop Elements class, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Becky and Larry will take more Wall of Fame photos at Art walk, October 7<sup>th</sup>, from 5:30 - 8:00 p.m.

**Sagebrush Arts Fest - Barbara North- Chairman, Carolyn Purnell Site Manager:** Barbara reported she will return her notes to the Art Center, including a list of entertainers and photos, for next chairpersons use. Carolyn said there were 62 vendors. Some negative feedback was, too many jewelry artists. (17 out of 62, high-quality jewelers). Artists sales were down some. The Art Yard was simplified this year, but worked well. Special thanks to Marlene Keller who provided the tables and chairs for Art Yard and to all volunteers. Awards were: Marilyn Heed 1<sup>st</sup>. Nathan Hemperly 2<sup>nd</sup>, and Steel and Fun 3<sup>rd</sup>. The collection of tax forms must be changed, 28 tax forms not collected. Carolyn said she will step back in 2012 and will not be working with Sagebrush. She will reserve the facility from ISU for 2012.

**PASI- Carolyn Purnell:** PASI meeting will be moved off site because of scheduling conflict. There is a class scheduled on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of October.

**Gallery- Peggy Anderson:** in January, the Capital Exhibit, the “Spirit of Idaho”, will be featured, instead of the scheduled “All Seasons” January Show. Nathan Hemperly will be called to exhibit with January show. “All Seasons” will be the February theme this one time only. Questions have been asked about moving Pastels to a separate category in the judged show. Refer to October Newsletter for details.

Becky Petersen asked if their photos from their Photo Walk, could be exhibited. They could be shown in the classroom, with their Juried Show.

**Education- Carolyn Purnell:** Pennie Wolf will teach an animal class beginning the 13<sup>th</sup> of October - November 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9:00- 12 p.m. Elesha Shuman’s class is scheduled 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of October. Ken Spencer has one more class, October 29<sup>th</sup>. He will teach from homework he gave after his first class, with critiques, etc. Carol Myers will teach small paintings and card class the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of November. Maggie Millward will teach a Children’s Class in November. Carolyn Purnell will teach a Children’s class on acrylics and ceramics in December. Most grant programs require on-going childrens’ classes. We cannot teach children under 8 years, unless we do a special class and have someone to teach. David Ewart, an artist from Oregon, will teach a portrait class November 1, 8, 15, 22 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. He will give a free demo, at Art Center on October 13, at 7 p.m.

**Hospitality- Dorothy Brzek:** Art walk set this Friday, October 7. Please come if you can. We appreciate the continuing support of the membership with refreshment donations and attendance on 1<sup>st</sup> Friday.

**This Old Bag - Carolyn Purnell - the Art Center Fund-raiser** is set October 15<sup>th</sup>, at Red Lion. Please buy (and sell) tickets. Tickets are \$25, which includes lunch, silent auction, entertainment, and Art show. Danene Taysom and Kathy Murdock are working with exhibiting artists. Tickets will be sold at Art walk and all next week.

Food Bank needs artists to exhibit on the 13<sup>th</sup> of October, tickets \$15.00. Artists can also donate an item for the silent auction. Call Carolyn Purnell if you want to participate.

There will be a celebration on Veteran’s day November 12, at the Don Aslett Museum, followed by a dinner at the Performing Arts Center. Tickets are \$50.00 and will be available all day at the Museum. Funds raised will benefit the hyperbaric chamber, at Bingham Memorial Hospital for treatment of veterans, and ISU nursing program and Veterans’ fund.

**New Business - Carolyn Purnell:** Two dozen gallery hangers have been ordered for the gallery.
