### **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

A big thank you goes out to all of those who helped keep the Art Center running smoothly while I was at a school in Tybee Island, GA. There were many hands doing a lot of work. Kudos go to Jan Stanek who always does a great job with the High School Show. The students are so creative and talented.

Bea Cowger of the Portneuf Photographic Club is in charge of the upcoming Photo Judged Show in April. If you need an application to enter this show, stop by the Art Center and get a form. All the instructions and dates are on this form for your convenience. The Gallery will be completely full of beautiful photographs during the month of April. During this show, we have a real treat for you. The photographers have invited Portneuf Gap, a blue-grass band to play during the show. They will be located in the classroom...the music will float into the Gallery...so come see all the photos and hear this nice music. A reception by the Photo Club will also be in the Gallery.

Alas, the new furnace for the apartments is being installed at this time. They begin the installation on Monday, March 21<sup>st</sup>. In talking with the electrician, the cost per month is going to be much cheaper than before. The Art Center, however, will initially incur the cost of the heat and electricity to run the boilers, until the contracts are renewed in June. At that time, the apartment rent will be increased to augment the cost to the Art Center. Why is this happening? The new boiler/furnace is one unit with three zones, but there is no way to monitor each separately and be billed directly to each apartment renter. It is connected to the Art Center main line and will therefore, be billed to us. We will ensure that this expense is taken care of in the near future as I have stated above. The electrician has indicated to me, however, that the expense will be minimal due to two factors. It is a new unit with updated and built-in thermostats and also, that the heat from our level at the Art Center is keeping the apartments warm. Only in the very cold temperatures will the new furnace run continuously.

We are nearing the pay-off of our mortgage. Only three more months....something for which the members of the Art Center have been striving. Congrats!

Check out the enclosed information on upcoming classes. We have many that may interest you. I also want to encourage you to take the watercolor class by Leslie Redhead who is coming in from Vancouver, British Columbia. She is a well-known watercolorist who is going to teach us a unique way of doing pours. She originates from Utah and has agreed to teach a seminar here in August, 2011!

Rikki Spinner has offered to do a children's class in painting ceramic tiles for Mother's Day and Father's Day. What is so special too about this offer is that she is donating her time, so all the profits go to the Art Center. So please sign up your children and grandchildren. There is an age limit so call the Art Center to sign them up for a new experience of art. Rikki will be firing the pieces and they will be available for pick-up prior to Mother's Day in May.

The good news for everyone is....the Sagebrush Arts Fest has been scheduled at ISU on the corner of 5<sup>th</sup> and Carter Streets for September 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Applications will soon be available.

Call To Order: Dorothy Chatterton, Vice President, called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

Minutes of Previous Meeting: Minutes unavailable for review.

Treasurer's Report: Sallee Gasser – Net income for the period \$1,832.09. Balance checking and savings is \$11,185.05.

OLD BUSINESS

Photography Club: Becky Petersen – Photography Club members will take artist's photographs for the Art Center's 'Wall of Fame' on the 4th Thursday of March at 8 p.m. A follow up photography session may be held in May. Biographies, provided by the artists, will be included with the photographs. Biography information could include name, medium, and place of residence, contact information and short bio. Photography Club members will prepare the photo/bio cards. Cost is \$0.55 or less per photo. Suggestion is to display the photographs on the double doors as a "wall of fame" or on a board displayed on a tripod. Suggestion is to display only cards of featured artists. Copies of other artist photos could be kept in an album for future shows. Peggy Anderson moved, Jane Guidinger seconded, that photo size shall be 4"x6". Motion carried.

On April 28 Carolyn Snell will teach the Photo Club how to incorporate feeling and mood into photographs. The Photoshop Elements class taught by John Bunker and Larry Petersen was a success. Bob Beason demonstrated how to use the mat cutter.

**GUIDELINES for the ANNUAL JUDGED SHOW  
(for additional info on exhibiting, refer to the Directory)**

1. You may enter up to 3 items at \$10.00 per item.
2. The 3 items can be any combination of categories, and/or levels at \$10.00 each.
3. **Paintings/art cannot be larger than 40" wide which includes the frame. The Gallery Committee will not accept any art that is larger than those dimensions. All art must be the artist's original work.**
4. All hanging art work must be framed and ready for hanging
5. No work from copyrighted material is acceptable
6. Work should have been completed within the last 3 years
7. All art must be identified on the Art Center card with artist name and title of art; any work for sale should be marked with a price on the Art Center card
8. Identifiable signatures on the front of paintings and other art will be covered during the judging process
9. Work that has won in past PAC Art Shows cannot be entered

1. Oil, Acrylic
2. Watercolor
3. Drawing—Pencil, Pastel, Colored Pencil, Pen & Ink, Charcoal
4. Photography, Digital Art (includes Computer Art)
5. Three Dimensional

***LEVELS***

- Level I: Amateur Artist**—a beginning artist. Class work is acceptable but must be original work of the artist.
- Level II: Intermediate Artist**—an artist who has worked independently in a medium over a period of time, has had training in the form of classes, private lessons or workshops, and may sell their Work occasionally.
- Level III: Advanced (Professional) Artist**—an artist who has had extensive training and/or worked independently in an art medium on a regular basis; and who has received awards in other shows; and one who sells their work or teaches...or both.
